LET'S GET TO IT

While we prefer long-term partnerships over short-term projects, we find that one of the easiest ways to initiate impactful collaborations is through a 3 month program model. The 12-week pilot could be as simple as having our heart-centered team bring one of our proven programs into your school *or* having one of our trained teaching artists collaborate with a classroom teacher to integrate expressive arts into their existing curriculum. For example, creating a project sequence or culminating project that aligns with *Into Reading* Modules across grade levels.

WE PROPOSE THE FOLLOWING

- A day time residency: 1 day per week for 12 weeks
- Minimum 2 class hours per visit to serve the kids and grade levels of your choosing
- A rate of \$150 per class hour (with modest weekly prep for the best 'art from a cart' you've ever seen)
- A flexible materials fee of \$25-95/ week (depending on number of students served)
- An optional culminating exhibit of your student's work at the end of the pilot

We recognize that meaningful arts programming is not one size fits all. We took the time to create this proposal in hopes of streamlining the collaboration process and helping you find a no-brainer way to utilize your state funds.
